

Peoria River City Youth City Rules

1. Bowlers must be sanctioned members of the Peoria River City USBC. Memberships will be available for purchase at the tournament.

2. Eligibility & Entry

*Team, Doubles, and Singles Division will be based on average

*Singles: A – 100 and below *Doubles: A – 200 and below

B – 101-150

B – 201-300

C – 151 and above

C – 301 and above

3. This is a handicap tournament based on averages. All events handicap will be free to all bowlers. Scores will be figured off the handicap score of the first time bowling each event. Divisions are same as Singles. Handicap is based on 80% Of 220.

4. Entrants will use their highest sanctioned USBC league average determined by the following order:

A. Highest 2021-2022 league average

B. If no 2021-2022 league average, the bowler will use current average of 12 or more games as of November 1st, 2022.

C. Bowlers without either average will bowl scratch (220)

5. Doubles and Singles may be bowled in the same squad, or split depending on bowler's preference, but must be declared prior to the squad beginning. Multiple participation is encouraged.

6. All prizes will be paid in scholarship money into the bowler's SMART account. Payouts will be based on a 1 in 5 ratio per division.

7. Check-in begins one hour prior to the scheduled squad start time. Entries close 15 minutes prior to the start of each squad.

8. ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES WILL BE SILENCED DURING BOWLING. No headgear, i.e. hats, headphones, etc., will be allowed during bowling. There will also be no use of vaping or electronic cigarette devices allowed while bowling is in session. No clothing displaying alcohol or tobacco products will be allowed.

9. In case of a tie, co-champions will be crowned. Winners in each division will receive a paid entry into the Illinois Youth State Tournament. (Singles, Doubles or Team, depending on which event is won.)

10. No one will be permitted in the bowler's area except for entered bowlers, tournament officials and/or official scorekeepers. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn, or they will receive a zero for that frame.

11. Use of any foreign substance will not be permitted during tournament play, except for rubbing alcohol being allowed to clean equipment during pandemic times.

12. No eating or drinking will be allowed in the bowler's area. All participants must wear bowling shoes.

13. USBC rules will apply to any rules not covered above. All rule interpretations will be at the discretion of the tournament director(s).
