ADULT/YOUTH BAKER DOUBLES RULES ** IMPORTANT ** ENTRANTS READ THOROUGHLY

- 1. All youth bowlers MUST be a certified USBC Youth member. Bowlers must also be in good standing with USBC to participate as this event is USBC certified. Adults must have a PRC Membership. These can be purchased at check-in in the amount of \$8 in IL. Check-in starts 30 minutes before squad time.
- 2. Entries will be accepted until squad time depending on the availability of lanes.
- 3. Entry fee is \$40: \$18 lineage, \$22 Scholarship.
- 4. There are six divisions: U12 Girls, U12 Boys, U15 Girls, U15 Boys, U18 Girls, and U18 Boys. Divisions will remain separated by gender if we have at least 4 entries within that age's division, otherwise genders will be combined by age. The age of the youth bowlers as of Aug. 1, 2024 will determine their division.
- 5. FORMAT: You will be bowling 6 Baker-style games. Baker-style games are where one bowler throws the first frame and their partner throws the next. The youth bowler will be on the odd (left lane) and the adult on the even (right) lane. The youth bowler will begin games 1, 3 and 5 and the adult will begin games 2, 4 and 6. Teams will bowl all 6 games on the same pair.
- **6.** Scholarships will be given for 1 out of every 5 entries in the divisions to be placed at USBC SMART Funds. All "scholarship fees" will be returned 100 percent.
- 7. No use of tobacco products, alcohol, or drugs, etc. will be permitted during the tournament. This is a smoke/alcohol free environment.
- 8. All other USBC rules will apply. The decision of the tournament director/s shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
- 9. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by reason beyond the control of the PRC USBC shall cause the prize awards to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in the tournament up to the time of termination.
- **10.** DRESS CODE: Dress casual and respectfully. No foul language graphics, no crop tops, wear appropriate length on shorts (everything covered).
