- Bowlers must be sanctioned members of the USBC and in good standing.
- Entry Fee is \$70: \$48 Lineage, \$20.50 Scholarship, \$1.50 Expenses
- Optional Scratch Entry option available for \$5.00 more.
- This is a handicap tournament based on averages. Scores will be figured off the handicap score of the first time bowling each event. Handicap is based on 90% of 220.
- There are 5 divisions: U10, U12, U14, U16, and U18. The age of the youth bowlers as of Aug. 1, 2025, will determine their division.
- Handicap will be based on the highest average of the 24-25 season or current average with at least 21 games. If no average is available, the bowler will bowl scratch.
- All prizes will be paid in scholarship money in the bowler's SMART account. Payouts will be based on a 1:4 ratio per division with a minimum of 3 spots.
- Check-in begins one hour prior to the scheduled squad start time. Entries close 10 minutes prior to the start of each squad.
- ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES WILL BE SILENCED DURING BOWLING. No headgear, i.e. hats, headphones/earbuds, etc., will be allowed during bowling. Medical headgear acceptable.
- No use of tobacco products, alcohol or drugs, etc. Will be permitted during the tournament. This is a smoke/alcohol free environment.
- Premature termination of the tournament brought about by reasons beyond the control of the PRC USBC shall cause the prize awards to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in the tournament up to the time of termination.
- No one will be permitted in the bowler's area except tournament bowlers, tournament official and/or official scorekeepers. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn, or they will receive a zero for the frame.
- Use of foreign substances will not be permitted during tournament play. Altering of the ball's surface is not allowed after practice is over.
- DRESS CODE: Bowling jersey's, bowling center shirts, and polo's are acceptable. No foul language graphics, no crop tops, no spaghetti straps, or crop tops are allowed. Shorts/skorts must be appropriate length. No sweatpants or holes in jean will be allowed.
- USBC rules will apply to any rules not covered above. All rule interpretations will be at the direction of the tournament director(s).
- Foul language will not be tolerated and may result in tournament disqualification at the discretion of the tournament director.
